EXPECTATIONS, RULES AND CODES OF CONDUCT FOR COACHES

- 1. Abide and uphold the rules of the club.
- 2. ALL coaches are representatives of the club and ambassadors of the sport and should not be commenting or passing judgements on individuals or the running of the club.
- 3. Teach your gymnasts to follow the club rules.
- 4. Never coach moves of a higher difficulty than your qualification allows.
- 5. All coaches should be punctual for the start of the sessions they have agreed to coach. (Notify the head coach or arrange for a cover coach if you are likely to be late or unable to attend the session.)
- 6. Ensure that, where possible, you give equal time and attention to the gymnasts in your group. 7. Appropriate sports clothing and footwear should be worn when coaching. (No jeans or
- 7. unsuitable casual wear.) WGC uniform should be worn at all times when coaching.
- 8. NO food or chewing gum should be taken into the training hall and no shoes or trainers should be worn in the training hall.
- 9. Be respectful and polite to others.
- 10. Bullying, humiliation, fighting, inappropriate language, making suggestive or inappropriate remarks to others will not be tolerated.
- 11. Jewellery must not be worn when coaching in the gym. (A flat wedding ring, preferably taped is permissible.)
- 12. Ensure the gym is left in a safe and tidy manner, with all equipment put back where it belongs.
- 13. Criticisms or concerns of any nature should be communicated through the management of the club. Coaches associated with the club must work as a team and work within the code of ethics of British Gymnastics.
